St Joseph's & English Martyrs 200 Club Rules

PURPOSE

The purpose of the 200 Club is to raise funds for English Martyrs Catholic Voluntary Academy and St Joseph's Parish.

RULES

- 1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number.
- 2. You may purchase more than one number.
- 3. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize, during the last Friday morning celebration assembly of the month at English Martyrs. If there is no celebration assembly on the last Friday of the month the draw will take place at the next Friday celebration assembly. The draw for July will take place at the final assembly before the beginning of the school holidays and the draw for August will take place at the first Friday celebration assembly for the new academic year.
- 4. The prize money will be: 1st prize of £100, 2nd prize of £20 and 3rd prize of £10. This may be subject to change by the FEM committee if membership numbers alter substantially.
- 5. The 200 Club is a private society lottery and is open to: parents, guardians or carers of pupils currently attending the school; members of St Joseph's Parish; staff currently employed at the school; any other friends, family or supporters of the school or Parish.
- 6. Participants must be aged 18 or over.
- 7. Membership of the 200 Club is not transferable.
- 8. Payments must be made by standing order (£2 monthly or £23 annually) or by cash or cheque for 6 or 12 monthly blocks (i.e. £12 or £24). One month's notice is required for cancellation. Payment annually by standing order is discounted by £1 to £23.
- 9. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 10. The winning cheques will be posted to the address on the membership application within one week of the draw whenever possible.
- 11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and in the Parish newsletter.
- 12. The 200 Club will be run by FEM. In case of any dispute the decision of the FEM Committee is final.
- 13. The FEM Committee reserve the right to amend these rules at their discretion.
- 14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 200 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be distributed equally between FEM and St Joseph's Parish after six months.
