# 1 General feedback from parents on remote learning and support for families to include any concerns facing parents with the return of children to school.

Those with children in school felt privileged and lucky to have their children in school but when they have had to access remote learning due to snow days etc this has been very smooth.

### Return to school

Parents worried about the location of tuck shop and the congestion it causes as well as lack of social distancing -this will be relocated – possibly on the playground.

It was suggested that if there was the need to raise the money still for school then FEM crowd funding could be set up with digit donations made to FEM.

A suggestion was also made that the staff made a video before the children returned to school so children could be reminded of who staff are.

Homework was discussed and it was decided that there will be no homework set until at least after the Easter half term.
