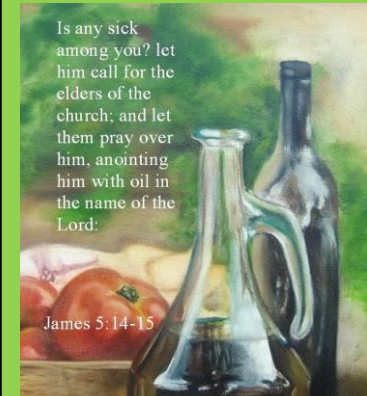
- I know something about the hospice movement.
