


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From September 2022, the Working Together to Improve School Attendance document replaces all previous guidance. Attendance is the essential foundation to positive outcomes for all pupils and only exceptional circumstances warrant granting a leave of absence. An absence will not be granted unless it has been applied for in advance. Parents should plan their holidays around school breaks and avoid seeking permission from school to take their children out of school during term time unless it is unavoidable. Failure to ensure your child's regular attendance at school is an offence under Section 444 of the Education Act 1996.

If the headteacher has not authorised the absence, then the Local Authority may take legal proceedings against you. This may result in:

- A Penalty Notice requiring payment of a penalty of up to £120 per parent per child. Failure to
 pay the penalty due will result in prosecution before Magistrates Court.
- Prosecution under Section 444(1) Education Act 1996, where if convicted you may be fined up to £1,000.
- Prosecution under Section 444(1a) Education Act 1996 where if convicted you may be fined up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence.

Please note that you may not be issued with Penalty Notice as the Local Authority may decide that it is appropriate to prosecute you without first offering an alternative.
