MATHS CHALLENGE



Well done to the 34 children from Y5&6 who took part in the UKMT Junior Maths Challenge recently. The results are particularly pleasing with 13 awards achieved:

- 2 children achieved a Platinum Award with scores over 120/135.
- 4 children achieved Gold Awards with scores between 90 and 119.
- 4 children achieved Silver Awards with scores between 80 and 89.
- 3 children achieved Bronze Awards with scores between 79 and 79.
- 13 awards is a superb achievement and very possibly our best performance as a school ever. All 13 awards winners will sit the UKM1
